Downtown Powder Springs is the heart of the City and home to the new Thurman Springs Park, featuring the Amphitheater, a place where residents and visitors can meet for recreation and entertainment. The Downtown also includes unique businesses for shopping and development opportunities for residential and commercial builders. Residents and visitors to Powder Springs enjoy the Silver Comet Trail, a 61.5-mile paved trail that runs through Cobb, Paulding and Polk counties. ## Workforce Development and Education

The city of Powder Springs is located in Cobb County, Georgia. The Cobb County School District is the second-largest school system in Georgia and is ranked one of the best in the nation. It serves nearly 113,000 students with 112 schools. Powder Springs is near eleven colleges and universities and a technical college producing a highly trained skilled workforce for area employers. Customized training for companies is available through Chattahoochee Technical College.
