Summary: The Police Department has a vehicle take home policy and is short four vehicles to supply its patrol officers. Two vehicles will be purchased now with additional tax revenues, and two will be purchased in March with the 2016 SPLOST program.

Two quotes were received. Approval is recommended to accept the quote submitted by Brennan Ford in the amount of \$92,409. The amount is \$595 more than the second quote but the vehicles will be available not later than February 5 while the others will not be available until mid to late March.
