The event sponsor Caterer shall be required to provide proof of alcohol beverage liability insurance in an amount equal to a minimum of \$1,000,000 and which shall name the City of Powder Springs as additional insured thereon.

The event sponsor shall be required to execute a Hold Harmless and Indemnification Agreement in a form acceptable to the City wherein the event sponsor shall agree to hold harmless and indemnify the City of Powder Springs from and against any and all liability, costs including attorney's fees, expenses, damages, suits, judgments and expenses arising from the event.

Terms & Conditions:

I hereby agree that as a condition to the issuance of an Alcoholic Beverage Catering Permit, the business owner/sponsor of the Event shall indemnify and hold the City harmless from claims, demand or cause of action which may arise from activities associated with the event. I hereby solemnly swear, subject to criminal penalties for false swearing, that the statements and answers made by me to the foregoing questions in this application for an Alcoholic Beverage Catering License are true, and no false or fraudulent statement or answer is made herein to procure the granting of such permit.

I hereby state and understand that should a complaint be filed against the owner/sponsor of the Event for violation of any regulation associated with the application for the City of Powder Springs Alcoholic Beverage Catering Permit, the permit issued for the event will immediately become void and will not be reissued for the same location. I hereby declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
